Needs Question: 2. Identify youth service need on which this project is based:

Needs Answer: According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, autism prevalence has risen to one in 88 children (1:54 boys; 1:252 girls). This is a 1000% increase over the last 40 years. These children are just a part of the one in 14 children in school with an identified special need. 1 We in the library world need to provide a new approach to literacy experiences for all children, including the rising number of children diagnosed with special needs. To provide the needed experiences for this patron group, library staff should be trained to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to meet this group's needs. Parents of children with special needs often dread public situations. Their child may throw themselves on the floor over an out-of-order automatic door and then face the disapproving stares of other adults. Families may isolate themselves to avoid the judgment of others. This isolation further limits the child's opportunity for social interaction. If we in the library world welcome these families and invite them to attend our functions that are tailored to meet their needs, we can model inclusiveness for the entire community. 2
"The very permanence and stability of the library in the community can be a useful aspect of the patron's socialization and education. If a child experiences acceptance, happiness, and success there, it can be a haven for the rest of his life." 3 We want Sump Memorial Library to offer acceptance, happiness, and success to all the children of our community. To accomplish this goal and become a model library for inclusive Sensory Friendly Storytimes we need three components: training by professionals in the areas of autism, Down syndrome, behavioral disorder and other diagnoses, materials to support the children with special needs and their families, and manipulatives and other items that would enhance a sensory storytime as suggested by Dr.

Background Information Question: 3. Background Information:

Background Information Answer: To create Sensory Friendly Storytimes, library staff need training on how to facilitate storytimes for children with a variety of diagnoses. A search of the Nebraska Library Commission's website and the Nebraska Library Association's website for training opportunities for library staff in the area of Sensory Friendly Storytimes and services for children with special needs indicates there is no training of this nature available to public library staff in Nebraska.

With Papillion's ever increasing number of preschool children, the need for quality programming for children with special needs rises exponentially. Papillion, ranked as the fifth best place to live in the United States by Money Magazine, sports a young, family oriented, quickly growing population. According to the U.S Census Bureau's American Fact Finder¹ for the years of 2005 – 2009, the median age of the population of the United States is 36.5. The median age of the Papillion population is 35.6. The average percent of households with children under the age of 5 in the United States is 6.9%. Papillion's percentage of households with children under 5 is 7.6%. Papillion's population is younger than average with more children under 5 than the average U.S. city. We have the potential to impact 2996 children under age 5, including all those with special needs, and their families and caregivers.

 8. Encourage parental participation in Sensory Storytime programs.

Program Question: 5. Description of program or activities:

Program Answer: Sump Memorial Library needs three different components to create a successful experience for both the library staff that attend the workshop and the children and their families that attend our Sensory Friendly Storytimes. These components will consist of:

1. A full day, free of charge professional development workshop for public library staff entitled: Serving Children with Special Needs through Sensory Friendly Storytimes.
2. Circulating materials, such as books and videos, on the topic of children with special needs and their families for the education and support of all children and parents.
3. Manipulatives and external supports (cubes, reading cushions, fidgets) for children with special needs attending the Sensory Friendly Storytimes.

Component # 1 - A full day, free of charge professional development workshop for public library staff entitled: Serving children with special needs through Sensory Friendly Storytimes.

For component one, the professional development workshop, we have identified a group of six professionals to offer training at Sump Memorial Library for library staff throughout the state. We will offer a free, full day training session for a maximum of 75 public library staff from Nebraska. Our topics will include: learning to recognize prevalence, symptoms, and techniques used for common childhood diagnoses, understanding and recognizing the common behavioral disorders in young children and their symptoms and how to address these behaviors as they occur in storytime, simple tips for working with young children with Autism Spectrum Disorder and much more. Below are the objectives from the six proposed speakers for the workshop:

Elizabeth Lilla, Doctor of Occupational therapy

1. Participants will learn to recognize prevalence, symptoms, and techniques used for common childhood diagnoses.
2. Participants will identify strategies to decrease challenging behavior during library storytimes.
3. Participants will experience activities designed to improve challenging behavior during storytime for children with special needs.

Teri McGill, Regional Coordinator of Nebraska Autistic Spectrum Disorders Network

1. Will present an overview of Autistic Spectrum Disorders.
2. Show how characteristics of Autism affect the learning and behavior of young children.
3. Give simple tips for working with children with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Tammy Olson, Training Coordinator Behaven Kids

1. Understand and recognize the common behavioral disorders in young children and their symptoms.
2. Address problem behavior as it occurs during storytime.
3. Increase and encourage positive behavior during storytime.
4. Encourage parental participation in the program.

Kristy Feden, School Psychologist, Early Childhood Facilitator, Papillion-LaVista School District

1. Participants will gain basic knowledge of characteristics of children with Down syndrome and other developmental delays.
2. Participants will be provided and will generate additional strategies to include children with Down syndrome and other developmental delays in group activities.
3. Participants will be provided and will generate ideas for modifying activities (differentiating learning targets and objectives, presentation, materials) and providing accommodations/supports so that children with Down syndrome and developmental delays can gain new skills through structured activities in the library setting.

Rene Kiernan, President of Nebraska Parent Responder Partnership

- 1.Participants will learn how to recognize and respond to children and young adults with autism.
- 2.Participants will learn how to interact with parents and caregivers of individuals with autism.
- 3.Participants will learn how to provide events and programs for the autism/special needs families in their communities.

Component #2 – Circulating materials, such as books and videos, on the topic of children with special needs and their families for the education and support of all children and parents.

The materials for component two will be chosen from recommended lists from associations such as the Down Syndrome Alliance, and suggestions from professionals. Titles will include The Goodenoughs Get in Sync, The Out-of-Sync Child: Recognizing and Coping with Sensory Processing Disorder, Tool Chest: for Teachers, Parents and Students Handbook and many more. A complete list of proposed titles will be mailed.

Component # 3 - Manipulatives and external supports (cubes, reading cushions, fidget) for children with special needs attending the Sensory Storytimes.

The purpose of the third component of the project, manipulatives and other items, is –to provide appropriate physical and sensory support for children with a wide variety of diagnoses. The target audience for this program includes children with autism/pervasive development disorder, Down syndrome, developmental delay, sensory processing disorder, dyspraxia, cerebral palsy, and ADD/ADHD. Each of the aforementioned diagnoses offers unique challenges which can be addressed using a variety of external supports. This grant is requesting several items such as manipulatives, balance discs, cubes, weighted stuffed animals, and bean bags which will assist children in positioning, physical support to combat fatigue, and retaining attention throughout the story time. – 1 A proposed list of items will be mailed.

We would like to offer our first Sensory Friendly Storytime during the month of April, 2013. The storytimes will be offered to children of all abilities and will feature the techniques taught in the workshop and will use the manipulatives and external supports purchased by the grant.
